Allardale Circuit Race Series

Held under American Bicycle Racing (ABR) Race Permit

SUNDAYS MAY 9 & 16, 2004

GRANGER TWP., OHIO

Our course is a rolling 5 mile circuit over well maintained rural-residential roads. From the start at Allardale County Park, the course proceeds east on Remsen Rd., south on Allard Rd., north on State Rd., then east on Remsen once again. The finish is on Allard Rd.

Registration is 8:30-9:45 AM at Allardale Park (note: the Park does not open until 8 AM. Parking is limited, so **please car-pool or ride to registration**). Restrooms and drinking water are available in the park.

From the northeast: take I-90 to I-271 S, get off at Ridge Rd./SR 94 (exit #3) and turn left (south), continue 0.5 miles and then turn left (east) on Remsen Rd. Proceed 2 miles to the Park, on your left-hand side.

From the west: take the Ohio Turnpike (I-80) to I-71 S, get off at exit 218. Turn left, go under Rte. 71, turn left again and re-enter I-71 N, then get off at the first exit (I-271 N). Take I-271 N to SR 94 (exit #3). Turn right, then left immediately on Remsen Rd. and continue for 2 miles to the Park on your left.

From the east: take I-76 to I-77 N, get off at SR 18 (exit #136) and proceed west for 4 miles to SR 94. Turn right and continue 3.5 miles to Remsen Rd., turn right and follow for 2 miles to the Park, on the left.

From the south: take I-71 N to I-271 N. The first exit is SR.94 (exit #3); get off there and turn right, then make a quick left onto Remsen Rd. and proceed 2 miles to the Park, on your left-hand side.

Entry is on a first-come, first-served basis (no advance registration, no late fee). Entry fee includes insurance surcharge and 1-day license. Categories are self-assigned, subject to Chief Referee's approval. The race takes place "rain or shine," except in cases of extreme weather (there is no postponement date); the promoter reserves the right to combine classes and adjust prize list if field minimum is not met.

All riders are welcome, and all [ABR Racing Rules](#) apply: **the course is open to auto traffic**, so **the center line rule is in effect at all times**. CPSC approved helmet **MUST** be worn at all times you are on your bicycle; tank tops and "time trial" bars are not allowed (Scott Rakes and Cane Creek Speedbars are OK). Sorry, no neutral or personal support vehicles.
